

ORDINANCE NO. 2129

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF TRAILERS, MOTOR HOMES OR RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ON THE STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON

WHEREAS, the Village of Dennison desires to regulate the parking of certain vehicles upon the public streets and alleys for the purpose of preserving for public and residential use all available parking areas for automobiles, non-commercial trucks and motorcycles and, further, for the benefit of the community.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Dennison, County of Tuscarawas, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1. That the parking of any trailer, motor home or recreational vehicle on the public streets or alleys of the Village shall be prohibited except as otherwise provided herein. A Trailer shall broadly be defined to include any vehicle used to transport water craft, campers, other vehicles, goods, persons, property or equipment, whether or not the vehicle is being utilized for such purpose or carries such item at the time.

SECTION 2. That any trailer, motor home, or recreational vehicle that is self propelled or otherwise physically attached in tow to a motor vehicle shall be prohibited from parking on the public streets or alleys of the Village for more than twenty-four (24) hours within any seven (7) day period.

SECTION 3. Whoever violates Section 1 or Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00. Each day that the offender remains in violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.
