

ORDINANCE NO. 1462

TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF ANIMALS

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Dennison, Tuscarawas County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. No person, being the owner of any animal or fowl, or harboring or having charge or control of the same, shall permit such animal or fowl to run at large in any street, lane, alley, market place or public ground of this municipality, or permit such animal or fowl to go upon or enter any private yard, lot, or inclosure, without consent of the owner of such yard, lot, or inclosure.

Section 2. Whoever violates Section 1 herein shall be fined not more than Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Dennison, the reason for such necessity being the requirement of protecting the inhabitants healthwise, and safety wise in the Village from animals running at large and shall therefore be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
