

ORDINANCE NO. 2246

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF
SKATEBOARDS, SCOOTERS AND ROLLER SKATES
FROM DESIGNATED AREAS WITHIN THE
VILLAGE OF DENNISON**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison is concerned regarding the damage to sidewalks, stairways and other structures of public property within the Village caused by the use of skateboards, non-motorized scooters and roller skates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Dennison as follows:

SECTION 1: The use of skateboards, scooters and roller skates shall be prohibited from areas of property owned, controlled and maintained by the Village of Dennison and where the Village has caused to be posted in a clearly visible location signs designating the prohibited use of said items in the area of the posting.

SECTION 2: Any person found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be charged with violation thereof, conviction of which shall be a minor misdemeanor on the first offense punishable by a fine of not more than \$150.00 upon each occurrence.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby deemed to be an emergency to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Dennison, Ohio and shall go into full force and effect on the first day after its passage by the Village Council as an emergency measure provided it receives the necessary votes.
