

ORDINANCE NO. 2423

**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING A CHILD PICK UP AND DROP OFF SPOT
FOR IMMACULATE CONCEPTION SCHOOL**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison has determined that it is necessary to designate a pick up and drop off spot for the students at Immaculate Conception School;

WHEREAS, Council feels that the designated pick up and drop off spot should be closed to all other traffic during the designated times;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, STATE OF OHIO;

- SECTION 1.** School Lane Alley, between North First Street and North Second Street, shall be designated as a pick up and drop off spot for students of Immaculate Conception School. Further, the East lane of North First Street, between School Lane Alley and Sherman Street, shall be designated as a pick up and drop off spot for students of Immaculate Conception School.
- SECTION 2.** That the Alleys or portions of streets designated herein as pick up and drop off spots shall be closed to the regular public from the hours of 7:00 A.M. until 8:00 A.M. and from the hours of 2:00 P.M. until 3:00 P.M., Monday through Friday.
- SECTION 3.** That the pick up and drop off spots shall only be restricted to general traffic during the months and dates when school is in session.
- SECTION 4.** Therefore, no person shall operate a motor vehicle on School Lane Alley, between North First Street and North Second Street, or the East lane of North First Street, between School Lane Alley and Sherman Street, during the restricted times, except for the purpose of picking up or dropping off a student.
- SECTION 5.** Anyone who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense, a fourth (4th) degree misdemeanor on the second offense, and a third (3rd) degree misdemeanor on any subsequent offense.
- SECTION 6.** The foregoing Ordinance was adopted and all actions and deliberations of the Village of Dennison, Tuscarawas County, Ohio relating thereto were conducted in open meetings to the public in compliance with all applicable legal requirements including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by Council and shall become effective upon passage by Council.
